

Admission to Prywatne Gimnazjum nr 33 pursuing Middle Years Programme is based on certain rules. These rules are to be obeyed in all cases by students starting their education at all levels at our school.

Rules of admission:

- Applicants are to pass English test which examines writing, reading and listening skills with a result of at least 50% of positive answers
- Applicants are to pass general knowledge test based on the curriculum of the already accomplished levels of education
- Applicants are to be interviewed in terms of their interests, accomplishments and plans for the future by the school's principal and MYP coordinator and are required to obtain a positive opinion as a result of both interviews
- Candidates are to fill in the application form (available at the school's website)
- Candidates are required to pay the entrance and exam fee
- Candidates' parents are to accept school's mission, school's statute, school's assessment policy and code of behaviour
- Parents are to sign school's educational agreement document
- Candidates are to submit required complete documentation: primary school certificate of completion, state competence test results certificate, school's application form and pictures
