
#### Tommy at home by Grade 0

I need to pass the small park and 5 streets, and finally at 7.55 I am at my school. It is a huge grey building, with dirty scratched walls, big windows with bars in the ground floor. It doesn't look nice. In my school there are about 2.500 students aged 6 to 14. There are a lot of classrooms, corridors, labs, teachers' rooms...it is easy to be lost in there.


#### by Grade 1a




#### English by Grade 2b






#### By Grade 3a


#### By Grade 3b

- Oh! Look! These are the first PYP schools in the world! Frankfurt International School and the International School of Amsterdam.






